



Suggested Tony Kart set up for normal Grip Circuits Tony Psylo on Dunlop SL1 tyre (Light)

- Rear Track: Tony Kart wheels, rim to rim, o/side to o/side;1260mm (1290mm max.)
- Front Track: Tony Kart wheels, Top of inside front rim to centre of kingpin 75mm_95mm
- Rear Bar; out
- Front bar; out
- Rear ride height; STD, i.e. chassis up, axle low
- Caster; add caster if circuit is twisty/tight (can be driver dependant) SL1 tyres on a Tony Chassis normally do not require caster, i.e. NO additional caster
- Rear wheel hubs; 63mm
- Rear axle; Tony type N 30 D.
- Front crash bar; Usually tight
- Front lower crash bar; tight
- Seat stays; none
- Side pods; loose (tighten to ADD grip)
- Tyre pressure; 20-24 psi
- Front wheel hub; short 55 mm
- Middle Bearing; REMOVE

This set up sheet is for circuits that offer normal grip levels for the duration of the event. It is not intended for a `Green` circuit or a circuit that has worn out stones.
